An important message from the City and County of San Francisco

Attention Resident:

In October of 2009 the Board of Supervisors approved San Francisco's Mandatory Recycling and Composting Ordinance. The new law **requires everyone in San Francisco to keep recyclables and compostables out of the trash.**

The Mandatory Recycling and Composting Ordinance requires that *"All persons in San Francisco must separate their refuse into recyclables, compostables and trash"* and *"No person may mix recyclables, compostables or trash, or deposit refuse of one type in a collection container designated for another type of refuse."*

Your building currently has blue bins for recyclables and black bins for trash that will go to landfill. **You will soon receive green bins for compostables**, which includes food and yard waste.
