3 **Resolution Authorizing Environment Department Funding Recommendations**
4 **for Grants Awards to Three Organizations During the Fiscal Years 2023-2025**
5 **Grant Cycle.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco Environment Department (“the Department”)
8 provides grant funding to nonprofit groups to further the City’s zero waste and
9 climate goals through robust community engagement; and

10 WHEREAS, On April 17, 2023, the Department released a request for
11 proposals for youth development activities and education, with an emphasis on
12 zero waste and its connection to climate change. These grant-funded projects will
13 provide hands-on, off-campus outdoor activities with a strong focus on
14 environmental justice for San Francisco youth in grades K-12. In addition, these
15 programs will promote sustainable environmental practices among young San
16 Franciscans, including in-school recycling, composting, and water conservation,
17 underscoring the relationship between zero waste and climate change and
18 demonstrating the impact each of us can have by incorporating sustainable
19 practices into everyday life; and

20 WHEREAS, The Commission on the Environment approved amendments to
21 Resolution File No. 2022-08-COE on December 6, 2022, requiring the
22 Environment Department to receive Commission on the Environment approval
23 before executing any new outgoing grant requiring anticipated expenditures by the
24 Department of \$100,000 or more, or executing any amendment on an existing
25 outgoing grant that will cumulatively increase anticipated expenditures by 50
26 percent or more and has an amended total of \$100,000 or more; now, therefore, be
27 it

1 RESOLVED, That the Commission on the Environment approves the award
 2 of three grants totaling \$75,000 to be disbursed during fiscal years 2023-2025 to
 3 the following organizations:
