3 **Resolution approving Department of the Environment Funding Recommendations for**
4 **Zero Waste grant awards to thirteen organizations in grant cycle period (FY 2017 –**
5 **2019)**

6 WHEREAS, The Zero Waste program of the Department of the Environment provides
7 grant funding to non-profit groups; and,

8 WHEREAS, the Zero Waste grant program is dedicated to funding projects that recover
9 material from San Francisco’s landfill, thereby assisting the City in achieving its goal of zero
10 waste, and achieving this at a low cost per ton of waste diverted; and,

11 WHEREAS, in addition to helping San Francisco reach its zero waste goals, these
12 grant funded projects achieve a range of co-benefits such as creating jobs, providing
13 classroom materials for educators, securing healthy food and books for low-income San
14 Franciscans, and building community; now, therefore, be it


15 RESOLVED, the Commission approves the award of Zero Waste grants, totaling
