3 **Resolution Approving Environment Department Contract Recommendation for**
4 **Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Through Fiscal Year 2027-2028.**

6 WHEREAS, The Environment Department (“Department”) executes
7 contracts with groups to further the City’s clean transportation goals; and

8 WHEREAS, On January 10, 2023, the Department released a request for
9 proposals for a third-party administrator of its Pre-Tax Commuter Benefit
10 Program, which will provide City employees with an incentive to use sustainable
11 transportation modes by administering a comprehensive, user-friendly web and
12 app-based ride-matching, incentive management, and trip planning software
13 platform. This will allow City employees to deduct pre-tax dollars from their
14 paycheck, up to the current maximum allowed by federal law, in order to pay for
15 transit and vanpool expenses; and

16 WHEREAS, The Commission on the Environment approved amendments to
17 Resolution File No. 2022-08-COE on December 6, 2022, requiring the
18 Environment Department to receive Commission on the Environment approval
19 before executing any new outgoing contract requiring anticipated expenditures by
20 the Department of \$1,000,000 or more, or executing any amendment on an existing
21 contract that will cumulatively increase anticipated expenditures by 50 percent or
22 more and has an amended total of \$1,000,000 or more; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Commission on the Environment approves the above
24 contract, totaling \$1,000,000, to be disbursed during fiscal year 2022-2023 through
25 fiscal year 2027-2028 to the following organization:
