[Amendment of Commission on the Environment Bylaws]

ADOPTION OF AMENDED BYLAWS FOR THE COMMISSION ON THE ENVIRONMENT

WHEREAS, The Commission currently holds its regular meetings on the third Monday of each month, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco conducts weekly Monday meetings and the Commission on the Environment seeks their input at Commission meetings, and

WHEREAS, the 9/80* work week schedule makes it difficult for Department of the Environment staff to attend Monday night Commission on the Environment meetings, and

WHEREAS, the Commission on the Environment wishes to hold its meetings on the third Tuesday of each month, rather than the third Monday therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commission on the Environment amends its bylaws to read as follows:

Section 4: Regular Meetings

Regular meetings shall be held on the third Tuesday of each month, except in the case of City-recognized holiday, when the meeting shall be held on the following Tuesday of that month. Meetings shall be held at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett, Jr., Place, Room 400, in the City and County of San Francisco.

* The 9/80-work week refers to city employees working extended hours during the work week to allow for one day off during each two-week work period.
