

1 [Landmark Tree Policy]

3 Resolution affirming the role of the Urban Forestry Council in the development and
4 implementation of a nomination, evaluation and removal process for landmark trees in
5 the City and County of San Francisco.

6 WHEREAS, The Environment Code, Chapter 12, Section 1203 charges the
7 Urban Forestry Council with developing criteria for a landmark/heritage tree program for
8 the City and County of San Francisco; and,

9 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors passed **Ordinance 0017-06 Amendment**
10 **to Public Works Code - Section 801, landmark trees, significant trees, and**
11 **penalties for violations** on January 20, 2006, which directs the Council to implement a
12 landmark tree program that includes nomination, evaluation and removal; now,
13 therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Urban Forestry Council has created and approved criteria
15 and forms for landmark tree evaluation and the Council submits these documents to the
16 Board of Supervisors; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Council is prepared to evaluate and process
18 landmark trees in accordance with the parameters of Ordinance.
