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Executive Summary

Inmar Rx Solutions, Inc (“Inmar”) was approved to operate a Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Program (“Plan”) on November 25, 2020 pursuant to the City and County of San Francisco Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Ordinance (“Ordinance”), Chapter 22, Division 1, Sections 2200-2219 and the San Francisco Department of the Environment Regulation SFE-16-01-SDDSO. This Annual Report is for the Reporting Period between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022. Capitalized terms used herein are the same as those used in Inmar’s approved Plan dated August 27, 2020 as revised October 13, 2020.

Inmar’s primary focus for the Reporting Period was to maintain the convenience standard outlined in Section 2205 of the Ordinance and expand the geographical spread of Kiosk Drop-Off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites. During the reporting period, Inmar operated three Kiosks, two of which closed during the Reporting Period, and 152 Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites.

Inmar completed a biennial survey of residents and health care providers in conjunction with the other approved Program Operator in the beginning of the Reporting Period. The results of the surveys led to the creation of Inmar’s “Do More” marketing proposal that was approved by the Department on September 27, 2022.

Inmar and the other Program Operator utilizes a single system of promotion for all promotional and outreach activities in San Francisco City and County. The Single System of Promotion (“SSP”) includes a common logo, creation and implementation of a neutrally-branded website and toll-free phone number, a royalty-free license for Inmar to use the other Program Operator’s kiosk signage and intellectual property, and the joint implementation of a biennial survey. In addition, the Single System of Promotion outlines a system that evenly divides Resident calls evenly between both Program Operators. In response to Section 4.3 of the Regulations, Inmar and the other Program Operator agree to evenly split all charges related to the Single System of Promotion including the neutrally-branded website creation and operation, call-center operations, biennial survey execution, and other program costs. See Appendix A for examples.

Inmar, along with the other approved Program Operator, continued to operate a joint neutrally-branded website and toll-free phone number within the Reporting Period. The URL for the neutrally-branded website is www.med-projectsf.org. The purpose of the joint website is to provide Residents with information pertaining to all Program Operator’s disposal options and outreach material. Residents can visit the neutral website to view a map and listing of drug disposal locations including Kiosk Drop-off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites from all Program Operators in San Francisco. The neutral site, toll-free number, and outreach materials are available in the five required languages: English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog (Filipino). This website provides direct links to both Program Operator’s individually branded websites where Residents can order Mailers and find additional information on the individual Program Operators.

Inmar continued to operate an individually branded website within the Reporting Period. The URL for the Inmar website is www.SafeMedicineDrop.com. The website can be translated into the five required languages including English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog (Filipino). Inmar’s website contains identical features to the neutrally-branded website including a map and list of Kiosk Drop-off Sites and Standard Mail-Back Distribution Sites from all Program Operators in San Francisco. Residents can request that Mailers including Standard Mail-Back Envelopes, Inhaler Mail-back Envelopes, and/or Auto-Injector Mail-Back Packages be sent directly to their residence with instructions on how to return covered drugs. The website provides additional information on Inmar’s Consumer Drug Take-Back Program including a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) section. See Appendix A for examples of promotional materials.

Additional outreach activities were conducted during the reporting period with the goal of meeting promotion requirements as outlined in Sections 1.3 and 1.4 of the Ordinance. The dates and results of these campaigns are listed in Appendix B.

1. Outreach Materials

Inmar provides easily-consumable educational materials for dissemination to interested parties including Residents, pharmacists, retailers, and health care practitioners upon request and at no charge. All materials are easily understandable by interested parties with varying levels of English proficiencies and leverage explanatory graphics to aid in comprehension. Materials are available in English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog.

These materials will:

- Provide instruction on how to safely store covered drugs at home
- Inform of the risks of disposing of Unwanted Covered Drugs in inappropriate waste streams (e.g., solid waste collection, sewer, or septic systems)
- Outline how to participate in the safe disposal of Unwanted Covered Drugs.

Please see Appendix A for example materials.

2. Biennial Survey

Inmar, in conjunction with the other Approved Operator as outlined in the Single System of Promotion, completed a biennial survey of residents and healthcare providers of the City and County of San Francisco in the first quarter of 2022. The resident survey interviewed over 1,200 residents utilizing online and telephone surveys. The provider survey interviewed over 200 healthcare providers located in San Francisco by utilizing online and telephone surveys. Both surveys were offered in the five Approved Languages: English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese, and Tagalog. Results of the survey were provided to the Department in May 2022 and are available on the Inmar website, www.safemedicinedrop.com.

3. Marketing Proposal

In response to the 2022 biennial survey results, Inmar created a marketing plan to enhance current program education efforts. Inmar titled this marketing plan the Inmar “Do More” proposal and offers a comprehensive plan of both digital and traditional marketing tactics. This proposal was conditionally approved by the Department on September 27, 2022.

Collection Recycling

Ordinance SEC.2209(a)(10) - A description of how collected packaging was recycled to the extent feasible, 6 including the recycling facility or facilities used

DEA § 1317.75(c) prohibits handling substances after they have been deposited into a Kiosk. For this reason, Inmar is unable to separate and recycle drug packaging. Inmar will, however, execute educational programs, as outlined in Section VI, to encourage City residents to separate Unwanted Covered Drugs from their packaging and recycle the packaging prior to disposal.

Even though regulations prevent us from recycling drug packaging, Inmar has an interest in reducing waste and improving our environment. Through our Rx Returns and related business lines, Inmar has saved over 20,000 barrels of oil, recovered over 11,000 megawatts of clean energy, and powered over 900 homes in the past two years alone. We will continue to look for opportunities to expand our eco-friendly efforts in the City.

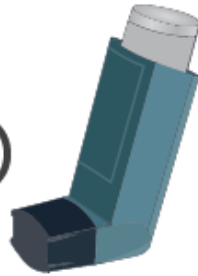

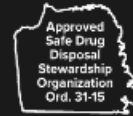
Figure 33 - www.SafeMedicineDrop.com Mail-Back Request - San Francisco

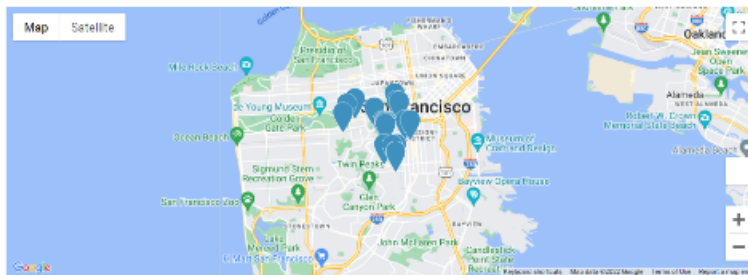


